Projects led by local communities

Our solidarity trips support initiatives that are requested by local populations and carried out independently of the arrival of Swiss groups. They offer a meaningful way to connect with villagers and assist them in achieving their goals. Participants gain insight into different realities, challenge preconceived ideas, and enjoy enriching experiences where genuine exchange is at the heart of it all.



A certified Non-Profit Organization

Supported by the Swiss Confederation, officially recognized as a non-profit, tax-exempt, and certified (Zewo, ISO, Entreprise citoyenne), our organization keeps operating costs as low as possible and does not seek to make financial profit from solidarity trips.



Preparation and awareness before departure

We train participants on the realities of the field, the pitfalls of “voluntourism,” and the “white savior” complex in order to foster respectful and balanced exchanges.



Long-term monitoring and commitment

We accompany groups before, during, and after their stay, and ensure continuous follow-up of the projects. The same goes for local groups. Each trip is unique and organized in a different village to prevent dependency.



Responsible and environmentally friendly trips
